CCNSG Safety Passport – the engineering construction industry safety card

The CCNSG (Client Contractor National Safety Group) Safety Passport is the engineering construction industry safety card. Workers must have a valid CCNSG Safety Passport to enter many engineering and construction sites. As a result, around 30,000 people complete the course each year.

The Renewal Course

The CCNSG Renewal Course is a one-day refresher course for those who have already completed the CCNSG National Course. Importantly, card holders must renew within three months of the safety passport expiry date or retake the two-day CCNSG National Course.

The CCNSG Renewal Course covers:

- The impact of an accident
- The importance of safe behaviour
- Legal framework
- Point Of Work Risk Assessment
- Permit to Work
- Good practice

The CCNSG Safety Passport expires after three years from the date of the national or renewal course. Importantly, candidates may come back for a one day renewal course up to three months after the safety passport card has expired. After that, candidates will be required to sit the two-day national course again.
